
Perseverance

A series of topic based, thematic sessions taught in half termly/termly
blocks following a progression of skills and the National Curriculum
(specific artists, artistic techniques and enquiry).

Pupil led interpretation of art. Independent experimentation to establish
techniques that are already mastered and to develop interests into areas
for further exploration.

Awareness of local art and the art in the wider environment, where pupils
are encouraged to discuss and comment upon what they have seen and
to be able to express a personal opinion using reasoned judgements.
Pupils will be taught subject specific vocabulary and use first hand
observation, knowledge and understanding as well as experimentation to
enhance their artistic talents. Appropriate targeted feedback will be given.
