





## Year 4 Multipliction Tables Check





#### Multiplication tables check

Helping schools ensure that all children know their times tables by the end of primary school.



# Statutory assessments

In Year 4, children will complete the Multiplications Table Check (MTC) in the Summer Term.

Children should be practising their times tables regularly at home. We recommend using Times Tables Rockstars. All children have been set on automatic training mode, which allows them to work through the tables at their own pace, only moving on when they are secure. They must initially complete 10 'studio sessions' to determine their initial level then do a 'gig' once a month to show progress. Soundcheck mode best replicates the MTC so we recommend these are completed regularly. In soundcheck mode, children should 'take their time' (6 seconds each question) as it won't affect their rock speed - something many children will worry about.

Children should know all of their times tables up to  $12 \times 12$ . We recommend the following order for mastering the tables:

10, 2, 5, 3, 4, 8, 6, 7, 9, 11, 12
